## Excellent Student Survey Results again in 2018

Our students in Grade 4-6 completed the Students Attitude to School Survey in May and we found some very pleasing results. 94% of students have High Expectations for Success, 86% for Effective Teaching Time and 85% for Differentiated Learning Challenge. These pleasing results follow on from the hard work staff have been doing to engage students in their learning and ensuring they are learning at their level. We still have improvements to make in terms of Classroom Behaviour (72%), as students have identified that students do need to show more Respect to Staff and Other students. These results give NEPS feedback on where we are successful and where we need to still improve.

Students are also able to order Gluten Free Pie or a Vegetarian Hot dog if they wish for the footy day lunch.

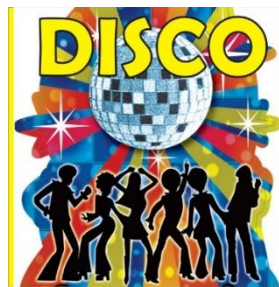
Just put a **GF** beside the Pie or a **V** next to the Hot Dog on the order form.
