Unwell Students

Children may have prolonged post-viral symptoms such as a runny nose or cough and may return to school following a negative COVID-19 test even if they are not completely free of symptoms. They will need a medical certificate from their GP to confirm they are otherwise well or have recovered from their acute illness. Students with a negative COVID-19 test whose symptoms have completely resolved do not need a medical certificate to return to the school.

Respectful Relationships Learning in Term 4.



As students come back to school in term they are finishing off the topic Gender and Identity. During this topic they have reflected on their own identity, and how they interact with those of the same or different gender, including adults. They've developed their understanding of gender norms and actions that underpin respectful gender relationships.

As the term moves on, students will begin the topic of Positive Gender Relations. In the early years they will develop an understanding of unfair or hurtful behaviours based on ideas about being a boy or a girl. They will be able to practise respectful and gender friendly behaviours. In the upper years, they will begin to identify different ways that gender-based violence might appear in face-to-face interactions and in the digital world. They will demonstrate the use of behaviours to maintain safety and dignity of themselves and others.

These topics support the NEPS Respect values towards, self, others, learning and community,

and support our students to develop lifelong respectful behaviours towards others.
