Student safety at Newborough East Primary School is our highest priority and the safe and appropriate supervision of students is an important element of our duty of care to students. Part of this duty is ensuring parents and students are aware of our student supervision arrangements before and after school.

Before school: School grounds are supervised at 8:30am – 8:45am. Students arriving prior to 8am; Parent will need to make arrangement with TheirCare. Students arriving between 8am and 8:30am will need to attend Breakfast Club.

After school: School grounds are supervised at 3:15pm -3:30pm.

Students on school grounds outside these times will **not** be supervised (unless they are attending a before or after school care program or Breakfast Club in the AM).

Families dropping of students and/or picking up are prohibited from using the staff car park for school and/or TheirCare drop off / pick up.

Parents/carers are requested to ensure that students do not attend school outside of these supervised times unless they are attending before or after school care, or a pre-arranged supervised activity (i.e. sports practice).

Families are encouraged to contact TheirCare on 0408855889 or refer to for more information about the before and after school care facilities available to our school community or if you would like any further information about our student supervision arrangements.
