
A Word from Mrs Skee

Expression of Interest - Buildings & Grounds Maintenance Position

Newborough East Primary School is seeking an EOI for a suitably qualified person to undertake buildings and grounds maintenance duties. This position, to replace a staff member on leave, is for 2 days a week from the 13th November to 18th December 2023. The suitable candidate must hold a current employee Working with Children Check and will be employed by the school as Casual Education Support. This position will be responsible for the maintenance and upkeep of the school grounds and undertake the following duties:

- Perform daily maintenance tasks as required (ie. replace light tubes, bin management, repair doors, attending to faulty locks, remove graffiti)
- Carry out cyclical maintenance works including painting, gutters and down pipes, check and remove debris
 from storm water drains as required.
- Opening and locking of door/gates
- Ability to climb ladder to clean gutters and retrieve sporting equipment
- Unblock sinks and pipes and perform simple plumbing maintenance
- General grounds maintenance ie. mowing, pruning, weeding etc.
- Assist with the set-up of school functions such as barbeques and sports days
