



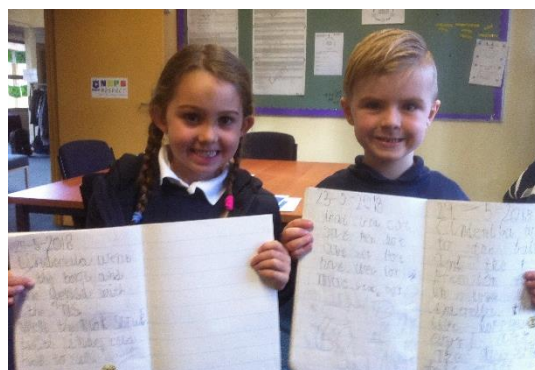

### Amazing Growth in Maths

NEPS students have had some excellent results recently, especially in Learning Growth. As an example of this, I met with Amelia and Marissa from Grade 3/4 (see pictured) last week as they have shown 2 years growth in their Essential Assessments in Maths. These girls have shown that with hard work and a willingness to see mistakes as learning opportunities and try again, great results can be achieved. Well done girls!

### Classroom Observations

I regularly visit classrooms to conduct observations, looking at whether students know what they are learning and how they will know if they are successful. This work is based around the successful implementation of the classroom Learning Intentions and Success Criteria. As we become more successful at achieving this as teachers, we will be able to continue to learn and develop.

The leadership team has now developed a Feedback template so that when we talk with teachers after the observations, we can follow a consistent script. Thank you to Prep DR for hosting my observation yesterday as I trialled the new Feedback Pentagon with Mrs Richardson.
