

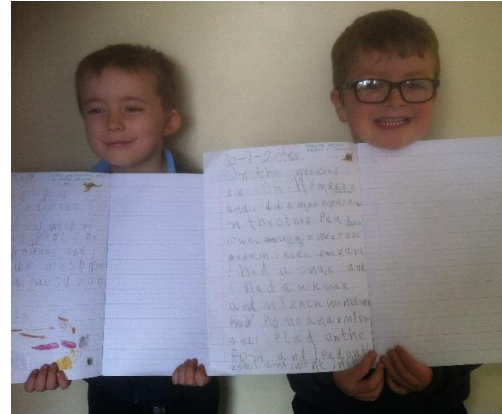

Classroom Observations

This year members of the NEPS Leadership Team have been conducting classroom observations, asking students about what they are learning, what is the purpose of their learning and what to do when they get stuck. These observations have led to a greater understanding of what goes on in a classroom and provides for some professional dialogue around student work. The Team have also developed a feedback strategy called the "POIRS Feedback Pentagon" so that feedback can be consistent across the school.

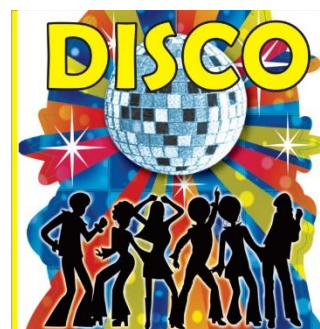
We hope that all families will participate to create a special moment at NEPS. Families can start submitting photos today.
