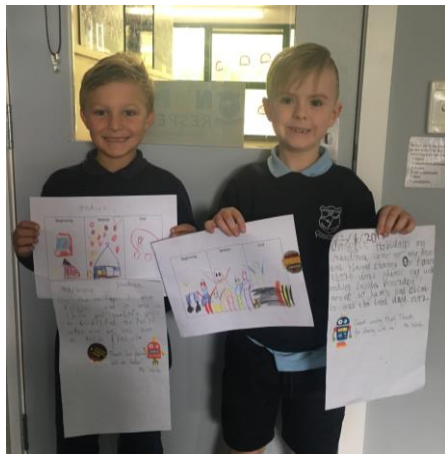
ANZAC day parade –
