Please note: The uniform color is **Navy not Black** and to have no labels or brand names.

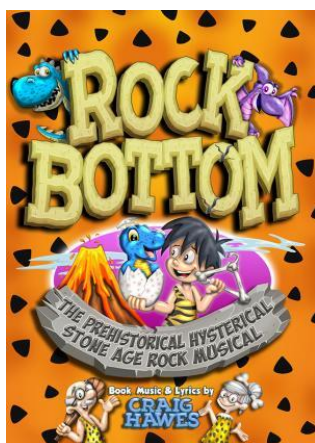
LOST PROPERTY
