The Swimming and Water Safety Program for students in **Room 1** will commence on **Tuesday 16th March** and will continue for 8 60 minute sessions.

Students will be involved in a variety of activities to develop their water safety skills and stroke development and work with two Australian trained teachers and assisting parents towards standards at the revised Life Saving Victorian Swim and Survive Active levels. *It is preferred that students bring their own goggles.*
